

THE HEART BEAT OF CHRIST COLLEGE

In the last couple of years, most of our reports on the growth of Christ College of Trans-Himalayan Wisdom have focused on the building program. This report will focus more on the development of an educational spiritual community.

Each month, a Solar Fire meditation is held in the Meditation Temple as close as possible to the actual time of the Full Moon. A talk is given prior to the meditation outlining the ray and astrological energies which are available at the time of the meditation. The meditations are advertised in the local paper.

In May, we began to use Long Bay House as the venue for our Language of Energy Course. The course includes in its curriculum: esoteric astrology, seven ray psychology, group work, cosmology, meditation, emotional healing work, ritual and much more. Three tutors provide a rich diversity of subjects interests and teaching styles.

This course is taught in five five-day intensives held every three months over a year. The students are housed in rental houses in Akaroa. Being at Christ College for such extended periods of time means that we are beginning to feel like we live there.

In October, two presenters of great inter-national reputation will provide workshops at Christ College. Tuija Robbins from Finland will provide a two-day workshop on the nature of and the creation of ritual. Her work has evolved out of twenty years of working with a community in the creation of monthly rituals. Michael Robbins from the U.S. will provide a two-day workshop on the Nature of Meditation. He is one the worlds most important exponents of occult meditation and will share 30+ years of practice.

And, of course, we visit the Temple at least weekly. Seeds for the future are being nurtured.
